

Workshop to introduce the topic:

Task is provided in Suetterlin writing without the separation of words:

(Questions 1 and 5-7 has to be answered by all groups.)

1. What expectations do you have? Which questions/issues would you like to be dealt with?

Group 1:

2. What is your understanding of culture?
3. What do you understand by illiteracy?
4. Have there been surveys about education in your countries? If so, which were the results?

Gruppe 2:

2. What is literacy training for you?
3. What do you understand by political participation?
4. What effects does illiteracy have on the people affected?

Gruppe 3:

2. What do you and people in your country understand by cultural participation?
3. What effects does illiteracy have on the social environment of the people affected?
4. How many illiterate people are there in your country?

5. How do you feel when you cannot read the task and have to do it? (This question applies to all groups)

6. What is the social status of illiterate people like in your countries? How are people who cannot read or write accepted in your country?

7. Where do you normally find illiterate people in your country, in rural or urban areas or city centres? Where do you normally find people who cannot read or write - in the countryside, in towns or in town centres?

Setting:

- Make up three groups (red, blue, green).
- When your groups are complete you will get the task.
- Every group works in the area of their group colour.
- In your working area you will find some help to complete the task
- First work out the questions and then answer them in your groups.

The participants got every documents in English but Sütterlin scripture.

As offers of assistance there were:

1. stage: table of initial sounds & dictionary
2. stage: audio - wordlist
3. stage: word & picture
4. stage: questions in easy language
5. stage: audio - complex questions are read twice – however, they are not read in the same order as the participants have

Very important: Please stick to the order of the stages in your workflow.

6. stage: every documents in English and Latin scripture
